School Report Card from USOE explanation

- 1) For several years schools have been given a letter grade according to performance, attendance, etc. New this year, schools are no longer given a letter grade but instead are graded on both the achievement and growth percentages on SAGE end of level exams for 3-6th grades
- 2) Mapleton Elementary performed above average in both district and state in all categories
- 3) Our largest growth percentage is among the population of the 25% lowest students - with a 63.7% increase.
- 4) Celebration that reteach groups and resource services are helping students show growth
- 5) School attendance average is 85.3%
