*The curriculum they present has been approved by the USBOE

*Teach a graduated curriculum that is age appropriate

*Teach 1 or 2 day sessions ranging in time from 45 minutes to 60 minutes each session

*Presentations are interactive for the students

*Teach the definition of child abuse (child = 0-17 years old; abuse = hurt or harmed on purpose)

*Teach the students reasons why child abuse might occur

*Teach the students that child abuse is usually not done by a stranger but more often by someone the child knows

*Teach the students the 4 types of abuse: physical, sexual, emotional, neglect (sexual relates only to touching and non-touching the private parts of the body. No other terms/vocabulary is used)

*Teach the students the 3 safety rules (3 R's);

Resist

*The curriculum will be available in the main office for parents to view 2 weeks prior to the presentation

*Parents are welcome to attend the presentations

*Only opt-out forms are required for parents to sign who do not wish for their student to participate
