Superintendent meeting report – Kristi Allan

- 1- Bond election will occur in November 2018
- 2- Currently there are 33K students in Nebo School District. It is proposed that by the year 2017 that number will double
- 3- No tax increase will occur if bond passes
- 4- Bond will be used to rebuild SHS, PHS & SFHS as well as 3 middle schools
- 5- Structure will provide a straight feeder secondary school program
- 6- New Mapleton middle school will be built on slant road and will open in 2021
- 7- There will be a 10 million dollar surplus. The district is accepting input on how this money should be spent

Training Video:

Focused on Trustlands

- 1- 1884 land parcels were divided by the State and put into an endowment
- 2- 96% beneficiary is public schools
- 3- Currently there remains 3.3 million acres of land – managed by a company named Sitla
- 4- Currently the endowment is worth about 2 billion dollars
- 5- Assets come from grazing, oil, gas, mining and real estate
- 6- Every public school in the state is given funds for use
- 7- Use of these funds is determined by the School Community Council which is made up of parents, teachers and administrators. Utah is the only state in the nation where a council is given the responsibility to determine how to use these funds
- 8- Funds must be spent after evaluating greatest academic need
