Superintendent SCC Meeting Report: Whitney & Kristy

1. Bond update – discussed where and when the schools will open
2. Discussed ow that transition will look for a middle school
3. Projected enrollment: Elementary – 500 students; Middle & Jr. High – 1200; High School- 1800
4. Discussed safety and security measures for schools including cell boosters installed in schools

Synopsis of 2018-19 school improvement plan goals and trustland expenditures – Julie

1. Dibels reading goal (grades 1-3) – data was presented and explanation was given as to the difference between students being proficient vs. students making typical growth in a school year. Both pieces of data are used to comprise our school percentage.
2. Math year end testing (grades 4-6) – RISE testing was used to measure this however at this time, the data presented by the state of Utah has not been "scrubbed" and is unreliable, so no data could be presented at this time.
3. Purchase technology to enhance classroom instruction – currently in grades 3-6 technology is 1:1 with a goal to move towards that ratio in the primary grades as well.
4. Art integration – grade level teams have incorporated 2 integrated art lessons into their curriculum maps
5. Detailed report was presented of trustlands money expenditures for 208-19 school year
6. A suggestion was made by Whitney Anderson to use some of trustlands professional development money to provide subs giving primary grade teachers the opportunity to overhaul the take home library

1. SAFE UT – app installed on phones for parents and students where anonymous tips can be given on issues such as suicide, bullying, depression, drugs, etc. Julie receives notification when a tip is given from a student at our school. It was decided unanimously by the SCC council to have Reilee Brinkerhoff the school counselor do a presentation introducing this program to our 5th and 6th grade students.
2. Prevent Child Abuse Utah (PCAutah.org) – empower students to help prevent child abuse in Utah. The organization will come to present to our SCC council and then we will decide if/how we would like to present this information to our students
