

Safe Walk/Bike Access Route

Mapleton Elementary School

In accordance with state standards, Mapleton School has identified school access routes for School students who live within the walk boundary established for the school. The intent of a safe walk route plan is not to identify every school access route or to identify the more convenient school access routes; it is to identify main walk/bike routes that are considered safer school access routes. Care has been taken to consult with local law enforcement, school PTA and School Community Council representatives, and the District's traffic safety committee in establishing these school access routes. Despite broad consultation and unanimous agreement from all parties involved in establishing these routes, no one, including the Nebo School District and Mapleton School can guarantee that the agreed upon school access routes are or will ever be completely free from hazards.

Parents are encouraged to walk or bike the school access routes with their child/children, to address specific concerns they may have, and to instruct their child/children to obey the laws and rules pertaining to pedestrian safety. If a parent feels their child/children should use a school access route that is not identified in this plan, it is a parent's prerogative.

As previously stated, the intent of a safe walk route plan is not to identify every school access route or to identify the more convenient school access routes. For this plan, school access routes leading to the school from areas where clusters of students live, have been identified and are described below.

School Access Route Descriptions:

Cluster A: Students living in the walk boundary north of 1600 N will cross at 1000 W. to 1200 N., stay on the sidewalk on north side of street, then east to 300 W where they will cross and then travel south to the school.

Cluster B: Student living in the walk boundary between 1600 N. and 1200 N. should travel south to 1200 N. then head east to 300 W. Cross to the west side at the cross walk, then south to the school.

Cluster C: Student living between 1100 N., 800 n. 800 w and 1600 W should travel to 800 N. then go east to 300 W. then turn south to the school.

Cluster D: Student living in the walk boundary bordering 1200 N., travel on 1200 N. to 300 W. then head south to the school.

Cluster E: Students living in the walk boundary bordering right along main street should use the sidewalk on the east side of Main Street to travel to the north side of Maple St. and then to the school.

Cluster F: Students living between 1100 N. and Maple St. and between 700 W. and 100 W. should travel to 300 W. and travel south to the school.

Cluster G: Students living between Main and 2000 E. and between 400 N. and Maple Street, including those bordering Maple Street or just below Maple Street should travel to 400 N. traveling on the north side of the sidewalk, then head west to Main Street, cross Main with the crossing guard and head to the school.

Cluster H: Students living between Main and 2000 E who border Maple Street should travel west on the north side of Maple Street to Main, then cross with the crossing guard and head to the school. Note that there are sections between 800 E. and 600 E. where there are no sidewalks but the north side is wider.

Cluster I: Students living in the walk boundary between 500 S. and 1000 S. and between 900 E. and 1600 E. should travel north to reach Maple St. then head west to Main Street, cross Main with the crossing guard and head to the school.

Cluster J: Students living between 100 W. and 900 E. and between 600 S. and 1100 S. should go to Main Street then to 800 S., then follow 800 S. to 800 W., then north to Maple Street staying on the south side of the street, then head east to the school and cross with the crossing guard.

Cluster K: Students living between 1100 S. and 1600 S. should travel to 1600 S. and head to 800 W and travel north to Maple St. Then head east to the school and cross Maple St. with the crossing guard.

Cluster L: Students living between 300 W and 1000 W. and between 400 S. and 1300 S. should travel to the east side of 800 W. and head north to the south side of Maple St. Then turn east and cross with the crossing guard when reaching the school. There are several areas without sidewalks.

Cluster M: Students living between 1100 W. and 1400 W. and between 500 S. and 1300 S. should travel to 800 S. and head east to 800 W. Cross to the east side and head north to 250 S. Turn right and curve around to 680 W. and then head north to Maple St. Finally turn east till they reach the school and cross with the crossing guard. There are several areas without sidewalks and 800 S. is a narrow dirt road which is why students are only traveling on it to reach 250 S.

Cluster N: Students living between 400 S. and Maple St. (or on Maple St.) and between 1600 W. and Main St. should travel to the south side of Maple St. and head east to cross with the crossing guard at the school.

Cluster O : Students living between 1200 W. and 800 W. and between 200 N. and 700 N. should travel to 1100 W. and head south to Maple St. Stay on the north side of Maple St. and head east on Maple St. and cross with the crossing guard when arriving at the school. There is a section of Maple St. without sidewalks.

Cluster P: Students living between Maple St. and 600 S. on the border of Main Street should travel north on Main Street, then turn west on the south side of Maple Street and cross with the crossing guard into the school.
