School Year: 2022-2023

**Goal:** *By the end of the 2022-2023 school year, the percentage of students in grades 1-3 performing on grade level or making typical progress in reading will increase by 1%.*

Nebo Goal (Board Goal) Connection: Elementary Reading

- *3rd grade students' reading proficiency will continue to exceed the current state standard and improve annually at the school level according to the ACADIENCE assessment.*

Action Plan(s):

1. We will hire a technician to maintain leveled library materials and provide access to reading materials for K-2nd grade students.
2. We will continue to run the Really Great Reading Phonics Programs for K-3rd grade students.
3. We will hire reading intervention technician(s) to aid our at-risk students with literacy concepts and skills.
4. We will meet monthly as grade level Professional Learning Communities with the principal, literacy specialist, and resource teachers to assess literacy needs, interventions, data, and best practices. We will hire four roaming substitutes to free up each grade level team.
5. We will continue to run the iReady Reading Program for all students.
6. We will continue to purchase new books for student use at home and at school, to help influence reading.
7. We will continue to purchase new technology devices such as chromebooks, ipads, chromebook carts and supporting software that is needed for students and teachers.

Measurements of Success:

Supporting Professional Development Activities (if applicable):

1. Teachers will be trained to implement a literacy approach by our instructional coach and during our monthly literacy PLC meeting.
2. Teachers will understand literacy assessments and how to isolate needed skills for individual students by our literacy specialist and during our monthly literacy PLC meeting.
3. Teachers will continue to receive mentoring, modeling, and training on best practices of reading and writing instruction from our literacy specialist, facilitator, and /or principal.
4. Teachers will be involved in Professional Learning Communities to help improve classroom instruction and student learning.
5. Professional development will be provided for teachers on literacy.

Action Plan(s):

1. Teachers will meet each week as a Professional Learning Community to discuss student data, interventions, strategies, re-teaching methods, and enrichment activities to increase student learning.
2. Grade levels will work together to implement a reteach-review-enrich model, along with CMI Math Instruction, to help support all learners.
3. We will hire math intervention technicians to help reinforce and enrich students' understanding.
4. We will continue to purchase new technology devices and supporting software that is needed for students and teachers.

Measurements of Success:

- *RISE Testing*

1. Teachers will continue to receive professional development throughout the year on the core and CMI math instruction.

Action Plan(s):

1. We will continue to run our 5<sup>th</sup> grade choir under the direction of a teacher and/or a parent volunteer when available.
2. One of our planning time specialists will be dedicated to the visual arts. The art teacher will reinforce the art core for each grade level through lessons that introduce students to a variety of art techniques and forms.
3. We will continue to have assemblies that showcase and introduce the students to a variety of the art disciplines in dance, music, visual arts, and drama.
4. Each grade level will continue to teach the arts core. Grade levels will engage in art activities to enhance their curriculum (i.e. class plays, choirs, programs, art galleries, dancing, etc.)
5. Teachers will participate in a curriculum planning day to help integrate the arts curriculum into their curriculum map.
6. We will continue to purchase new technology devices and supporting software that is needed for students and teachers. We will look for programs, software and apps that will support classrooms in the Fine Arts curriculum area.

Measurements of Success:

- *GAINS Survey data provided from the district.*
- *100% of grade level teams that have included fine arts in the curriculum maps.*

Supporting Professional Development Activities (if applicable):

1. Our arts specialist will continue to receive training and provide information and professional development to our staff.
2. District and State arts workshops will be offered and encouraged.
3. Nebo planning time teacher training.

### Action Plan(s):

1. Teachers, staff, and the principal will continue to review and support school wide safety and behavior rules. The principal will visit with each grade level to review safety policies such as bullying, weapons, drugs, fighting, profanity, sexual harassment, etc.
2. We will hire a Skill Building Coach to aid students with behavior and/or academic needs and run the Wellness Room.
3. We will concentrate on positive character traits throughout the year and spotlight students who exemplify good citizenship and other Mighty Mountaineer traits.
4. We will practice monthly safety drills including fire, earthquake, lockdown, lockout and shelter in place.
5. We will promote healthy lifestyle choices by participating in the N.O.V.A. program, good nutrition curriculum, health and safety week, and encourage increased exercise.
6. We will maintain emergency kits in each classroom.
7. The School Counselor will teach classes on a regular basis supporting safe school and healthy lifestyles.
8. We will hold a monthly at-risk and tat team meeting with teachers and the administrator to discuss students with behavior and academic issues. We will work as a team to implement interventions.

### Measurements of Success:

-Safe school issues will be tracked in iCampus, a Skill Building Report, as well as in our at-risk team meeting.

### Supporting Professional Development Activities (if applicable):

1. Principal will review safe school policies with faculty and staff at the beginning of the year as well as when new concerns arise.
