Goal: *By the end of the 2023-2024 school year, the percentage of students in grades 1-3 performing on grade level or making typical progress in reading will increase by 1%.*

- *3rd grade students' reading proficiency will continue to exceed the current state standard and improve annually at the school level according to the ACADIENCE assessment.*

Action Plan(s):

1. We will hire a technician to maintain leveled library materials and provide access to reading materials for K-2nd grade students.
2. We will continue to run the Really Great Reading Phonics Programs for K-3rd grade students.
3. We will hire reading intervention technician(s) to aid our at-risk students with literacy concepts and skills.
4. We will meet monthly as grade level Professional Learning Communities with the principal, literacy specialist, and resource teachers to assess literacy needs, interventions, data, and best practices. We will hire four roaming substitutes to free up each grade level team.
5. We will continue to run the iReady Reading Program for all students.
6. We will continue to purchase new books for student use at home and at school, to help influence reading.
7. We will continue to purchase new technology devices such as chromebooks, ipads, chromebook carts and supporting software that is needed for students and teachers.

Supporting Professional Development Activities (if applicable):

1. Teachers will be trained to implement a literacy approach by our instructional coach and during our monthly literacy PLC meeting.
2. Teachers will understand literacy assessments and how to isolate needed skills for individual students by our literacy specialist and during our monthly literacy PLC meeting.
3. Teachers will continue to receive mentoring, modeling, and training on best practices of reading and writing instruction from our literacy specialist, facilitator, and /or principal.
4. Teachers will be involved in Professional Learning Communities to help improve classroom instruction and student learning.
5. Professional development will be provided for teachers on literacy.

2. Grade levels will work together to implement a reteach-review-enrich model, along with CMI Math Instruction, to help support all learners.
3. We will hire math intervention technicians to help reinforce and enrich students' understanding.
4. We will continue to purchase new technology devices and supporting software that is needed for students and teachers.
